

## ONWARD DISCUSSION PROMPTS

















## These Onward discussion prompts have been created by a group of district leaders for all supervisors to use during team meetings throughout 2022.

- The purpose of these cards is to help us be reminded of the connections between our daily work and our Onward outcomes.
- Before using, create a space that is safe for team members to share, and have an atmosphere of encouragement as you celebrate your accomplishments.
- Option 1: Game. Invite everyone to write responses and take turns having one team member choose the best answer. (Think: Cards For Belonging!)
- Option 2: Discussion. Facilitate a more serious discussion in however much time you have available, whether 10 mins or a full hour.
- At the end of each discussion/game, brainstorm as a team ways that you can celebrate your accomplishments and share these stories with people who use our services, their families, district leadership, social media etc.

Describe a recent interaction with a family member where they showed new understanding or openness to their loved one trying something new.















Many of the people who use our services lost access to places where they belong during the pandemic. What's your favourite example of someone who found a new way of accessing community?











Tell us about a time when someone moved past a barrier to access a community where everybody belongs.















Let's brainstorm some places where people who use our services could begin the process of belonging in their communities even more than they currently do.















Among the people who use our services, who made a new connection last year? (Friend / workplace / other). How did that connection happen?
