In communities challenged by poverty, children with disabilities are the most vulnerable. Caregivers must weigh the risks of leaving a child at home alone to enter the workforce or stay at home and risk hunger. The supports and services that we take for granted in Canada are not available in most countries. For example, 90% of children with disabilities do not have access to education in developing nations.

Karis Disability Services is active and partnering with in-country organizations in six developing nations, working with people with disabilities and whole communities. Through inclusive education and sustainable development, we equip families and communities to earn a livelihood and care for one another. All of our global work is funded by donations.
