"But now you must be holy in everything you do, just as God who chose you is holy. For the Scriptures say, 'You must be holy because I am holy."

1 PETER 1:15-16, NLT

Holiness reflects God's own nature, setting His people apart. Peter's call reminds us that holiness is not about religious perfection but about aligning every aspect of our lives with God's character. How do my words, actions, or choices reflect the God who calls me His own?

Prayer Points

- We are thankful to have had the opportunity to serve families in the North as we hosted a Winter Family Camp. We pray that it was an encouraging and meaningful weekend for everybody.
- Pray for peace and stability in Haiti. Pray that God will work in the hearts of those who lead.

March 9 - 15

"And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns."

PHILIPPIANS 1:6, NLT

Paul reassures believers that God's transformative work in them is ongoing and secure. This verse encourages us to trust in God's faithfulness, even when we feel incomplete. Take comfort this week: God is working patiently in you, shaping you into a vessel of His love and grace. How might this truth bring you hope today?

Prayer Points

- We pray for wisdom and grace as Direct Support Professionals support people as they age and the complications that sometimes accompany this process.
- Pray for the leaders who govern in Haiti. Pray that they lead with wisdom, integrity and a heart for the Haitian people.

"Since God chose you to be the holy people he loves, you must clothe yourselves with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience."

COLOSSIANS 3:12, NLT

We're chosen to live out God's love in real and practical ways. Mercy, kindness, and patience are powerful tools of holiness. These qualities aren't accidental. They are choices rooted in our identity as God's beloved. Reflect on how humility and patience might deepen your relationships and reflect God's love in your daily life.

Prayer Points

- We Praise God for a vibrant Muskoka Our Voices Matter group that had an opportunity to speak to our MP and advocate for services they need.
- Pray for our partners in Haiti, including the United Brethren in Christ churches in Haiti who are reaching out in Jesus' name.

"Because we have these promises, dear friends, let us cleanse ourselves from everything that can defile our body or spirit. And let us work toward complete holiness because we fear God."

2 CORINTHIANS 7:1, NLT

Paul connects God's promises to the call to pursue holiness. We're called to remove anything that hinders our walk with God; not so we can earn His love, but in response to His love. This week, consider: What habits or attitudes might be holding you back from fully embracing God's presence?

Prayer Points

- We pray for new housing opportunities to support people in need in our communities, including people with developmental disabilities.
- Please lift up those who feel lonely, discouraged, tired of living in fear and uncertainty around the world.
 Pray for God's presence to give hope and strength for each day.
